

What's new in Web Security and Control

This release features several frequently requested reporting enhancements, adding unprecedented insight into internet activity while continuing to make everyday administration easier.



Answer important questions with new and enhanced reports:

What types of sites are users visiting?

- » Use the new User Visits by Category report to quickly and easily see who has visited undesirable categories, such as adult or gambling sites
- » Valuable for establishing or fine-tuning acceptable use policy
- » Drill down into individual user activity to see the full extent of their online behaviour

Are users performing inappropriate search queries?

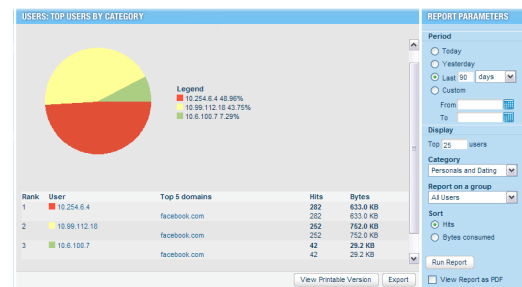
- » Use the new search queries report to determine who is searching on inappropriate terms
- » Customize included search term lists for adult, hacking, and violence or create your own by importing inappropriate search terms from other sources
- » Receive optional email alerts when inappropriate search terms have been flagged

Who or what is consuming the most bandwidth?

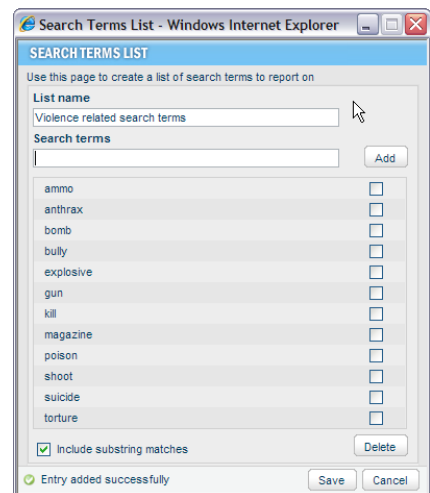
- » Use the enhanced Sites and Top Bandwidth Users report to determine which sites and users are consuming the most bandwidth
- » Sort reports by bytes consumed, site visits, or unique users
- » Drill down on any site or individual for in-depth analysis

Who is proceeding past warnings?

- » Use the new Warned Sites report to determine what questionable sites are still being visited despite warnings to fine-tune policy settings or investigate continued questionable user behavior
- » See the number of warnings issued, the users that proceeded, and drill down for a detailed look at recent activity that bypassed warnings


New reporting features

Exclude sites and domains from reports

- » Gain more accurate insights and reduce the noise associated with common web traffic to focus on what's really important
- » Easily exclude yourdomain.com, anydomain.com or entire site categories that may be skewing your reports due to frequent but legitimate activity

Use new report parameters

- » Change the number of users detailed in reports from the default 25 to any number of users
- » Now report on activity with a granularity of minutes – ideal for reviewing recent activity or troubleshooting
- » Use the expanded filter and sort capabilities on many reports to custom tailor the report to your specific needs




Exempt sites and domains from reports

Leverage multi-level drill-down

- » All user and content reports now support multi-level drill-down which is great for reviewing detailed user activity and for forensic purposes
- » Simply click any user or site in a report to drill down and investigate who's visited the site, how often, and when
- » Filter Activity Search results by site to understand the extent of a user's activity on a particular site or domain

Implement Syslog support

- » Automatically transfer web traffic logs to a syslog server for archiving and further in-depth reporting and analysis
- » Support for UDP, TCP, and encrypted TCP connections to safeguard your data
